

Eidsvold Saleyard Market Report
25th January 2012
Eidsvold Heifers top 226c

A quality yarding for the first sale of the year saw 476 head offered with cattle mainly drawn from the local area. All values from the last December sale lifted marginally in most categories due to strong local restocker influence and competition from feedlots.

A large consignment of yearling steers in the 200-300 kg range topped the sale at 243c returning the Vendors \$683/head. Medium range steers 300-400kgs made 207c fetching \$772. A smaller yarding of Feeder steers over the 400kg mark brought 197c at \$832 while a small show of heavy steers returned the Vendors 173c making \$943. Heifers were in high demand making 226c at \$584 up to the 300kg mark while 300-400 kg range heifers brought a commendable 198c returning the vendors \$703. Restocker heifers up to 500kgs made 162c returning \$425. A fair consignment of aged fat cows to the 520 kg mark returned 147c bringing \$688 with cows over 520 kgs made 151c fetching \$860. A handful of lighter bulls up to 450 kgs sold to a top of 105c returning \$467.

Forward bookings for the Special Santa Infused Show Store Sale are indicating a large yarding of all lines of cattle to be held on Thursday the 23rd February.
